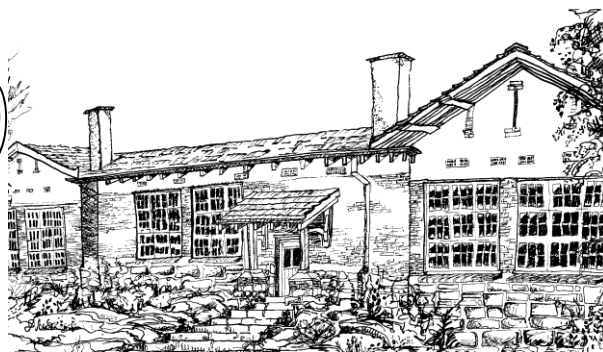

Recent Questions

Email your question.

Q: When is the Halloween disco?

A: Friday 27 October. Flyer attached.

Q: When is the interschool athletics?

A: October 24 (field events) and 25 (track events). We will be sending a yr3-6 team on both days. Letters home this week. \$5 for each day on bus.

Q: What is SIM?

A: School of Instrumental Music. (We have specialist music teachers who visit the school).

Q: How do you get into SIM?

A: All students are tested at the relevant age for musical aptitude. Those that score the highest are screened for physical ability by the instrumental music teachers. Those that show aptitude AND have the necessary physical ability are offered instrumental music tuition.

Q: When do SIM lessons get offered?

A: In the next couple of weeks.

Q: What instruments do you offer?

A: Flute, trumpet, trombone, clarinet (years 5-6)
Violin (year 3-6)
Cello (years 4-6)
We generally offer between 3 and 5 places per year group.
