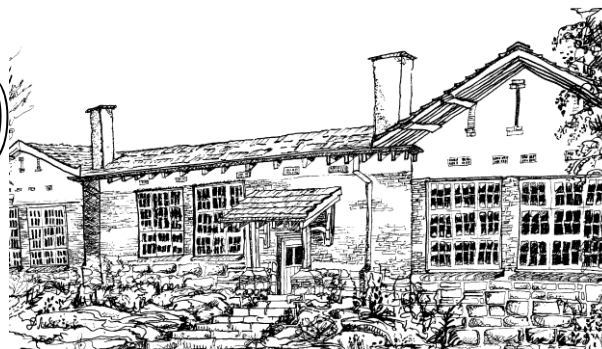

Email your question.

Q: When can I enrol for 2019?

A: Enrolment forms are available from the office.

Q: What is the ANZAC service timing for parent reps making wreaths?

A:

- 8.15 am Parent reps start to create wreaths
- 8.30 am Set up starts in the quad
- 8.55am Classes assemble in the quad.
- 9.00 am Service begins.

Q: How many flowers should we bring for ANZAC?

A: Each class needs a wreath so each child should please just bring 4-5 flowers on the day (2 May)

Q: When is the ANZAC assembly?

A: Wednesday 2 May in the quad. The date has been changed as our guest speaker couldn't make it. Sorry for any inconvenience.

Q: Do parents always get notified if their child is getting a certificate at assembly?

A: As far as we can. About 60 children get a certificate each assembly, so sometimes things slip through.
