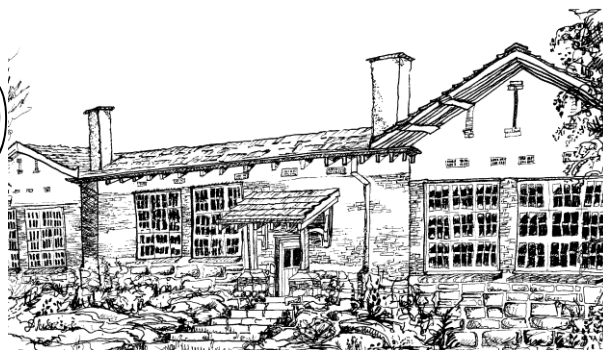

Recent Questions

Email your question.

Q: Can you ask parents not to park on the verges on bin day please, as neighbour's bins don't get collected if blocked by parked cars.

A: As above.

Q: Could you please explain how both the gold and pink slip processes work?

A: Gold slips are awarded by teachers for good behaviour. They can be awarded for anything. The original goes home with the student. The carbon copy goes into the gold box in the office. In assembly, the Student Council draws out a slip at random and that student gets a canteen voucher.

Pink slips are given for poor behaviour. Again the original goes home with the student. The carbon copy goes into the red box in the office and is recorded on our behaviour management system. Each pink slip serves as a reprimand and a chance for the student to correct their behaviour. At four pink slips, parents receive a letter with a print out of slips and the student does lunchtime detention.

Q: Please can I have my child's WA student number?

A: They get issued one in secondary school.

Q: When do we get Naplan results?

A: Usually not until September.
