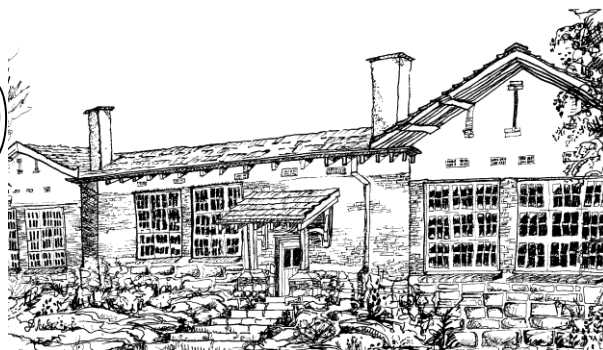

Seasons for Growth is an innovative grief and loss education program that uses the imagery of the seasons to illustrate the experience of grief. It aims to strengthen the social and emotional wellbeing of children and young people (aged 6-12 years) who are dealing with significant life changes such as someone they love dying, their parents divorcing or feeling like everything is changing.
