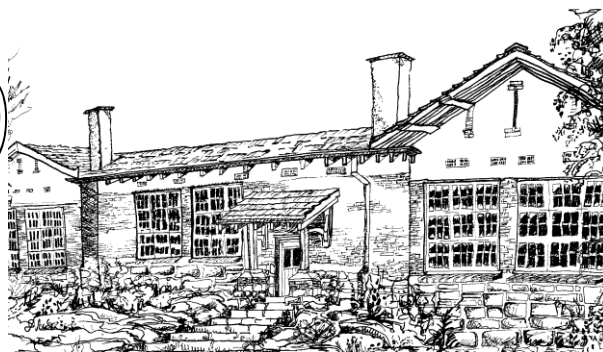

Questions

Please email me any quick queries or questions and I will respond as soon as I can. Recent questions below.

Q: If I pay the school & P&C fees via Campion, will the school receive the money now or do Campion hold the funds?

A: Campion holds the funds until about week 6 in term 1 next year. This is actually our preference. If parents pay us now or early or one at a time, our accounting is much harder than if everyone just pays Campion and we get one cheque for the whole lot.

Q: Why is the canteen not open on Mondays?

A: We used to open Monday, Wednesday and Friday but three days was not viable due to lack of volunteers so we dropped the least busy day which was Monday.

Q: What's the story with bandannas?

A: The student council is selling them all week for \$4 to raise money for children with cancer. Everyone may wear them, for school this week. Bandanna day is Friday 28 October.

Q: I don't use email, how can I get school news?

A: All newsletters are also on our website

Q: How can I get more involved in the school and/or have my opinion heard?

A: Beyond assisting at a classroom level, the main avenues for whole-school parent involvement and discussion are the P&C and Council. You can also email Lisa with queries and specific issues, but with 700 parents, the best avenues for general ideas and suggestions are these two parent forums. Lisa is on both committees.

Q: Why was disco information emailed home, not sent as a hard copy?

A: The School Council has asked that we use email for communication whenever possible. We plan to increasingly phase out hard copies of notes.

Q: I don't get emails

A: Please ensure we have your correct email address.

A: East Freo football club. Tomorrow.

Q: Is the disco Halloween fancy dress?

A: Optional but encouraged. There will be costume prizes.
