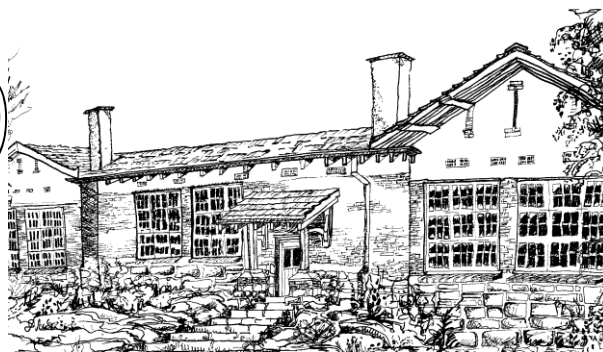

Q: Where can I read about school uniform?

A: White or navy. Yes but they must be under a skirt or shorts. Leggings alone are not acceptable 'bottoms'.
