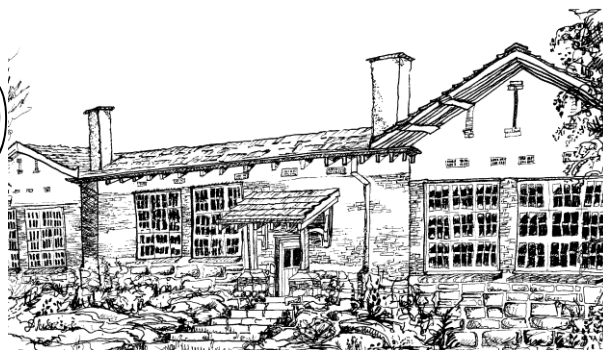

Recent Questions

Email your question.

Q: What secondary school do students go to?

A: There are lots of schools that they go to. Over time the proportion that goes to John Curtin College of the Arts has grown and this is now our main destination school. Next year, nineteen of our year 6's plan to go there. We are not a 'feeder school' for JCCA. Acceptance there is based on where you live, not which primary school you attend. But if you live in our intake zone you can go there as a local student as our zone overlaps with theirs. If you don't live in our local intake zone, check with JCCA.

Q: What month does our class get free bread?

A: Each child will be offered a loyalty card for an allocated month depending on their year group and there is no limit to how many cards you can have over the year with more than one child.

Jo leaves cards in each child's classroom one week prior to their allocated month.

Q: I heard we have to apply this year for Gifted and Talent Programs 2019?
