Recent Questions

Email your question.

Q: What do we do re schooling if we take the children travelling for a few months? **A:** The Education Act says that children should be at a school. Options are:

- 1. Enrol them at the School of Distance Education children do school work online with an assigned tutor. The student must be travelling overseas for a minimum of one school semester or 20 school weeks. (Proof: airline tickets and itinerary) The student should not have access to an English speaking school.
- 2. Register yourself with the WA Education Department as a Home Educator. You would have to demonstrate to the Education Department that you are fulfilling all requirements of the WA curriculum.
- 3. Enrol them at a school abroad.
- 4. Obviously the last option is they miss school and are recorded on the roll as 'unauthorised absence' or 'unauthorised vacation'. The school doesn't provide work. But we would suggest you continue with Reading Eggs, Mathletics and any other class work books or assignments. It is also a good idea to keep a travel diary.

Q: Is there a school policy on giving out party invitations at school?

A: We prefer that invitations be given out outside of school, but if that's not practical, teachers will hand them out for you discreetly at the end of the day. It can be very demoralising when everyone else is publicly invited and you are left out.

Q: When can I apply for 2018 kindy? **A:** During term 3, starting 26 April.

Q: Is kindergarten compulsory?

A: No. In Western Australia, children can start their education in kindergarten, however compulsory schooling starts in pre-primary. All children of compulsory school age (PP) must be enrolled in school and attend every day – this is the law.

Q: How do I enrol at Richmond?
A: To enrol your kindergarten or pre-primary child for 2018, collect an application for enrolment form from our office or website and apply during term 3 (starting 26 April closing 21

July). It is likely all kindergarten places will be taken by the closing date.

Q: Can we look around the school before enrolling?

A: A school tour for interested parents will be conducted on Thursday, 25th May at 10am. Call 9339 5055 to book a place on the tour.

Q: Just wondering if the school is going to issue parents with an invoice for the lump sum payment scheme for incursions/excursions 2017

A: No, we aren't as it's optional. Parents just come into the office to pay into their account and we will debit their child's expenses through the year. We do hope that eventually the majority of families will choose the lump sum option as it's easier for everyone. All children have an account set up now ready for use.

Q: When are main school photos? **A:** Thursday 9th March

Q: When do we bring in the photo envelope?
A: If you are paying online by credit card there is no need to return an envelope. If you are paying with cash please complete an order form for EACH child. Ensure correct payment is enclosed in the supplied envelope when placing your order. If you are paying with cash please return the envelope on the scheduled photography day (This is to avoid large sums of money being stored at the school).

Q: What if I forget to order photos? **A:** Parents are able to order online for 5 days after the photography day. This will not attract any further charges.

Q: What if my child isn't there on Thursday? **A:** Kapture will have a studio catch up day at their studio in Balcatta. Ring Lara in our office to find out about this.

Q: When are sibling photos?


